

**CITY OF KNOB NOSTER**  
**Board of Aldermen Session**  
**Meeting Minutes—February 5, 2026**

1. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.
2. Invocation.
3. MAYOR BYERLY called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. All present included: ALDERMEN THERING, CHARRETTE, KLEOPPEL, STAUFFER-BAUM and SMITH. A quorum was verified.
4. ALDERMAN CHARRETTE made motion to expand the Agenda to add Item 12: Discussion Regarding Alleyway Behind the Christian Church with a second by ALDERMAN SMITH. Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays. Motion was made to approve the amended Agenda by ALDERMAN CHARRETTE with a second by ALDERMAN SMITH. Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
5. ALDERMAN CHARRETTE to approve the consent agenda consisting of a motion:
  - a. Approving minutes of the January 20, 2025, Board of Aldermen meeting minutes.ALDERMAN STAUFFER-BAUM seconded the motion. Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
6. The Board of Aldermen reviewed the bill list.
7. ALDERMAN CHARRETTE said that there were potholes needing repair on Summit. MAYOR BYERLY said that anyone who would like to participate in the Knob Noster Senior Care group please contact City Hall.
8. Marisol Escobar, Vice President of the Knob Noster Chamber of Commerce, thanked the City for their 2026 donation. She is very excited about the partnership with the City and the engagement the community has displayed. She relayed that the Chocolate Crawl would be held downtown this Saturday.
9. The City Administrator relayed his report.
10. Motion to pass Bill No. 020326-B: An Ordinance Authorizing the City Administrator and City Clerk to Execute and Enter into a Master Services Agreement, with Marvin Wesley, LLC, Missouri for Services in Connection with Community Development and Infrastructure Projects in the City of Knob Noster, Missouri, to its first reading, by title only, was made by ALDERMAN CHARRETTE, with a second by ALDERMAN STAUFFER-BAUM.

11. Discussion was held regarding the bids received for a sprayer for pre-treating city roads before icy conditions. Motion was made by ALDERMAN STAUFFER-BAUM to purchase Option 2, Buyers Products Cordless Vehicle-Mounted Sprayer from Key Hydraulics for \$3,962.40 with a second by ALDERMAN THERING. Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
12. Discussion was held regarding the alleyway behind the Christian Church. Alderman Charrette relayed that they wish to pave this alleyway and he queried whether the city would allow that to happen. The city has no problem with the Christian Church paving their alleyway. Some discussion was held regarding replacing the culvert before the paving. The city will replace this culvert before paving and maintain the paved alleyway.
13. Motion was made at 6:28pm by ALDERMAN KLEOPPEL to go into Closed Session Pursuant to Section 610.021 RSMo, Paragraph 3, Personnel and Paragraph 9, Preparation for Contract Negotiations with a second by ALDERMAN THERING.
