

CITY OF KNOB NOSTER
Board of Aldermen Meeting Minutes
April 3, 2018

1. MAYOR PRO TEM BABINEAUX called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. ALDERMAN BABINEAUX, COHEN, THERING and ANGELES were present. A quorum was verified.
2. The March 6, 2018, meeting minutes were reviewed by the Board of Aldermen.
3. The Board of Aldermen reviewed the bill list.
4. ALDERMAN ANGELES stated that there were numerous potholes in her ward. ALDERMAN THERING stated that he had numerous potholes on 7th Street and Irish Lane. He also handed out a flyer he had received from the Mainstreet Convention he attended.
5. George Cromer of 126 NE 991, Knob Noster, stated that there was interest in the upcoming Flea Market on May 5, 2018. He asked that the 4-way be shut down for food trucks and the Flea Market from 6am to 6pm.

10. Discussion was held regarding waiving yard sale fees for the City-Wide Yard Sale scheduled for May 12-13, 2018. Motion was made by ALDERMAN ANGELES to waive yard sale fees for the City-Wide Yard Sale by ALDERMAN ANGELES with a second by ALERMAN COHEN.

Motion carried 4 ayes to 0 nays.

11. Motion was made to adjourn at 7:23 p.m. by ALDERMAN ANGELES and was seconded by ALDERMAN COHEN.
