

CITY OF KNOB NOSTER
Board of Aldermen Meeting Minutes
August 1, 2017

1. MAYOR MORTON called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. ALDERMAN COHEN, BRENT, ANGELES, BABINEAUX, and CHARRETTE were present. A quorum was verified.
2. The July 18, 2017, meeting minutes were reviewed by the Board of Aldermen.
3. The City Council reviewed the bills presented.
4. ALDERMAN BABINEAUX inquired about the MoDot meeting the MAYOR had attended regarding sidewalk ownership/repair. He stated that patrons were asking him about the sidewalk meeting and he had not been informed that it was happening. The City Administrator stated that the meeting went well with the MoDot representative with much needed clarification of who owns the sidewalks on State and McPherson Streets. ALDERMAN BABINEAUX asked, if possible, the Board move the bi-monthly meeting to 6:00p.m. instead of 7:00p.m. ALDERMAN COHEN stated that it looked as if the City has numerous dogs running free. ALDERMAN BRENT inquired if the City enforces the Municipal Code Book regarding loose dogs. The CA stated that the City Ordinance addresses "dangerous" dogs. MAYOR MORTON asked about the 700 East McPherson yard sale issues. He was briefed by the City Administrator.
5. Mr. Steve Miller, 139 NE 1271 Road, Knob Noster, addressed the Board regarding the overgrown/abandoned Catholic cemetery. He stated that if any of the deceased in the cemetery were veterans, perhaps could get help from military for initial clean and then the Church takeover maintenance.
6. Discussion was held regarding appointing the President of the Board. Motion was made by ALDERMAN COHEN to appoint ALDERMAN BABINEAUX as President of the Board with a second by ALDERMAN CHARRETTE.

Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays, and 1 abstention (BABINEAUX).
7. Discussion was held regarding the website design bids previously received. Motion was made to table this matter by ALDERMAN BABINEAUX and was seconded by ALDERMAN CHARRETTE.

Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
8. Discussion was held regarding the next Board Meeting on August 15, 2017. The back-to-school block party and meeting the teachers is also on August 15, 2017. Due to the conflict, ALDERMAN CHARRETTE made a motion to move the Aug. 15 meeting to Thursday, August 17 at 7:00p.m. with a second by ALDERMAN BABINEAUX.

Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
9. Motion to pass Bill No. 080117-A: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR STP-URBAN PROGRAM FUNDING THE KNOB NOSTER WASHINGTON STREET PROJECT to its first reading, by title only, was made by ALDERMAN COHEN and seconded by ALDERSON BABINEAUX.

Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.

Mayor Morton had the City Clerk present the bill.

Motion to pass Bill No. 080117-A to its second reading, by title only, and conduct a roll call vote was made by ALDERMAN CHARRETTE and seconded by ALDERMAN COHEN.

Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.

MAYOR HALL had the City Clerk present the Bill.
