

**CITY OF KNOB NOSTER**  
**Board of Aldermen Meeting Minutes**  
**July 2, 2019**

1. MAYOR MORTON called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. ALDERMAN BABINEAUX, LIECHTI, COHEN, CHARRETTE, and THERING were present. A quorum was verified.
2. The June 16, 2019, meeting minutes were reviewed by the Board of Aldermen.
3. The Board of Aldermen reviewed the bill list.
4. ALDERMAN BABINEAUX stated that the street sign on Lucas Street was spelled "Lucus". ALDERMAN CHARRETTE stated there was tall grass at the old trailer court near N. Monroe and Lucas, 206 Lucas Street and the Milton Bratten house on Adams Street. He stated that water is going under the road at the intersection of Summit and Dogwood on the north west corner. He also stated that the street in front of Tequila Jalisco Mexican Restaurant needs repair. ALDERMAN THERING stated that the KNRC Flea Market is July 6<sup>th</sup> from 8a.m. to 2p.m. ALDERMAN LIECHTI applauded the Public Works/Street Department for their hard work sealing the streets in preparation for Johnson County to lay chip and seal product. MAYOR MORTON stated that the Town Hall Meeting would be at the Jubilation Center on July 23, 2019, from 6-8p.m. He hopes all ALDERMEN will attend. He inquired to see if any ALDERMEN would be attending Base Community Council and deadline for RSVP is July 10, 2019. ALDERMAN LIECHTI affirmed he will attend. MAYOR MORTON read a letter from Matthew Johnson, KN attendee for Boys State thanking ALDERMAN BABINEAUX and ALDERMAN CHARRETTE for their donation for him to be able to attend.
5. City Administrator's report.
6. There was no public participation.
7. Discussion was held to regarding bids submitted for the Water/Sewer Department for a new Sewer Jetter. The old jetter has been in use in the City for approximately 20 years and parts for repairs are becoming obsolete. Bids submitted included: HotJetUSA--\$39,995.00; Key Equipment and Supply Co.--\$66,950.00; and RED Municipal and Industrial Equipment Co.--\$60,000.00. Motion was made by ALDERMAN THERING to approve the bid submitted by HotJetUSA for \$39,995.00 with a second by ALDERMAN COHEN.

Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.

8. Discussion was held regarding the Backyard Chicken Permit Applications received from Lisa Musser of 107 North Grant Street and David Cotner of 106 North Grant Street. The Building Inspector, Bart Amsbaugh, has approved both plot plans on the applications. Motion was made by ALDERMAN COHEN to approve the Backyard Chicken Permit for Lisa Musser, 107 N. Grant, and David Cotner, 106 N. Grant with a second by ALDERMAN LIECHTI  
Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
9. Motion was made to adjourn at 7:25 p.m. by ALDERMAN COHEN and was seconded by ALDERMAN THERING.

Motion carried 5 ayes to 0 nays.
