ANNUAL REPORT

2018

It has been my pleasure to serve the citizens of Knob Noster for another year. The year 2018 was a memorable year in many positive ways. It was the first full year of being in the brand new building. This raised moral in the department to higher levels. We had amazing support of the community for the efforts put forth by the men and women on patrol and in dispatch.

We traded in our old Glock 22 and 23 service pistols in .40 S&W caliber and received brand new Glock 17 and 19 9mm service pistols. The cost of the new weapons was negated by the trade ins and a \$1,500 grant from the Warrensburg Elks Club. The grant had a lot to do with the Knob Noster Court Clerk, Paula West who is an Elk. The change to 9mm will save the city almost \$100 per case of duty and practice ammunition

We also traded in our older short barreled shotguns for newer models. They are used Remington models 870s but in very good condition and have pistol grips. Some of the officers had slight difficulty in qualifying with the 14 inch barrel shotgun that needed a waiver from the ATF to have in the patrol vehicles. The cost of these shotguns was low to the fact that the older ones were traded in to a licensed dealer who assisted with the transfer paperwork for the ATF. Total cost of the shotguns was around \$250 per weapon.

All of the patrol officers now have new ballistic vests. These are personally fitted to each of the officers. This had been a major concern with the Mayor and the citizens of the community. Some citizens even donated money to the city when Kansas City citizens started the "Back the Blue" fund drive for new vest in that city and surrounding communities. Once again, I am humbled and very appreciative of the support giving by the citizens of this city.

Sgt. Houston and Officer Moore who assisted on the pistol grand also got a Walmart grant for \$1000 for new radios. I am surprised by the support we get from outside our community here in Johnson County.

In 2018 we lost Officer Melissa Merrill who went to full time dispatcher. This has kept six officers on duty with one slot still open. We have been staffed in dispatch for the entire year. New hires join, get trained in two months and within another month have found a higher paying job. I believe that six people were hired and departed in 2018 for the dispatch section. Currently there are three full dispatchers and two part time dispatchers.

2018 had a sharp increase in the number of suicidal subjects that this department had to deal with. There were 38 calls of suicidal subjects including several juveniles. A small three of these subject committed suicide. To help the department deal with number of people needing help, we now have three trained Crisis Intervention Tea, members on the department. My goal is to get two more trained so all officers at the Sergeant level and below will be CIT certified. Having these trained personnel has helped on all of the calls for help within our community.

I look forward to the year 2019 with great anticipation with a new City Administrator and a better outlook for the city and this department. I am very proud of the officers and dispatcher working for this department and see the professionalism on a day to day basis. I will strive to improve this department to the best of my ability. I greatly appreciated all of the help that the Mayor, Board of Aldermen, City Administrator and the city staff have given us throughout this year. I look forward to continuing my service to Knob Noster for as long as I can make a positive impact in this city.
