**An Ordinance Providing For East Allen Street To Be Changed To W.T. Morris Avenue**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Knob Noster owns East Allen Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to change the name of East Allen Street upon request by his widow, Ms. Dianna Morris:

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Knob Noster, Missouri, hereby declare it necessary to change the name of a certain street designated on the city street map, in the current city limits of Knob Noster, Missouri, as follows:

<u>Current Name</u>	<u>Change To</u>
East Allen Street	W.T. Morris Avenue

**WHEREAS**, Missouri State Statutes authorize a process by which the Board of Alderman may change street names by first publishing notice of same and stating their intent through the passage of Resolution 412; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF KNOB NOSTER, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The street currently identified as East Allen Street is hereby renamed “W.T. Morris Avenue.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen on this 2nd day of May, 2023.
