City of Knob Noster Valued Customers,

We are asking for your assistance in completing a federally-mandated inventory of all water lines in Knob Noster. Water lines and connections that are made of lead have been found to pose significant health risks to those who consume water from them. As such, the Environmental Protection Agency has adopted a Lead and Copper Rule, and has tasked all water suppliers with identifying the material of all water line connections in their systems, both public and private, to determine the number of existing lead water lines. This includes the connection of your private line to your house, business, or other structure that is served by Knob Noster water!

This is where we need your Help! We are kindly asking you to help us determine what the material of the water line connected to your house is made of.

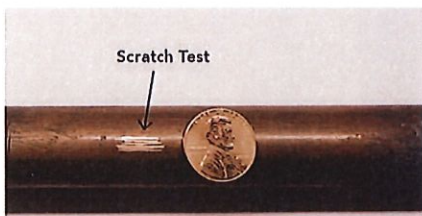
Enclosed is a short questionnaire we are requesting to be completed and returned to our office no later than **May 31, 2023**.

The inventorying of every water line is a huge undertaking for our water system and your help is greatly appreciated.

Copper Pipe

Copper pipe may be shiny, like a new penny, or orange/brown in color. When scratched it will shine like a new penny. Copper pipe is not magnetic, so a magnet will not stick to it.



Galvanized Steel Pipe

Galvanized steel pipe may be shiny or dull, silver or gray in color, and shiny like a new nickel when scratched. A magnet will stick to it.



Lead Pipe

Lead pipe will be a dull silver, or blue-gray in color. Lead pipe will be shiny when scratched. Lead pipe is not magnetic, so a magnet will not stick to it.
